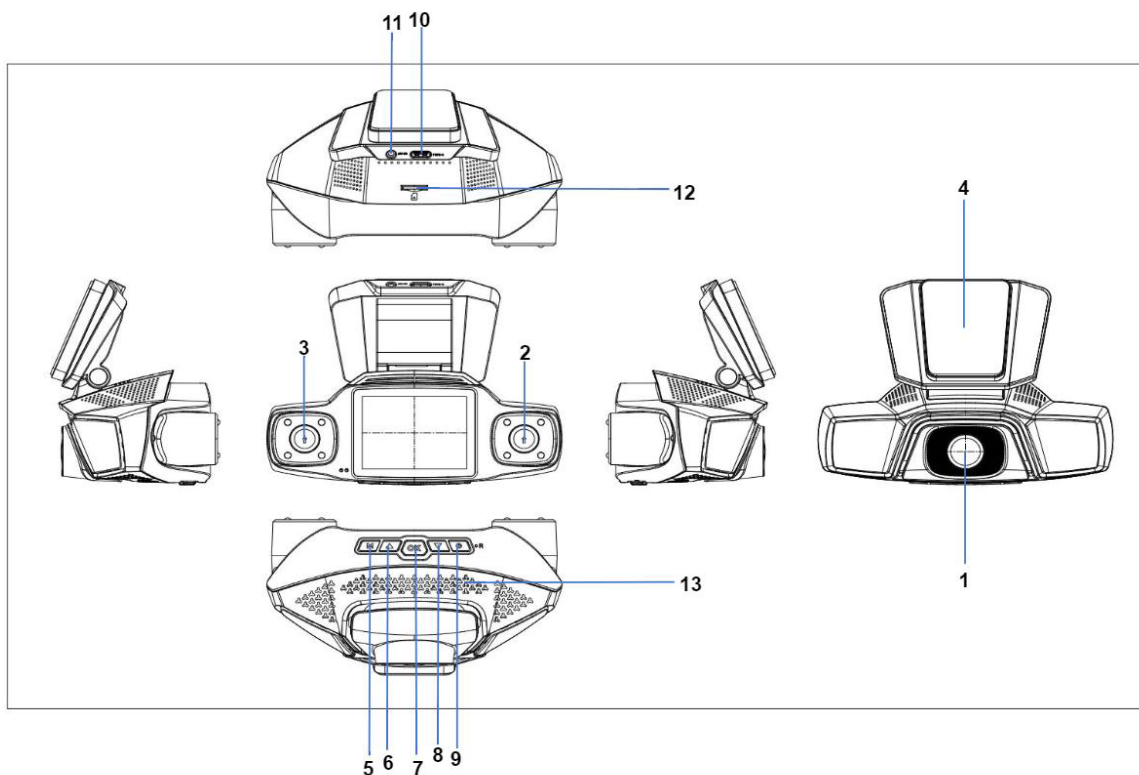

Quick Guide

1. Insert a MicroSD card into the dashcam to store videos. Use a high-speed MicroSD card.
2. Connect the GT810 dashcam to the 3M sticker holder and attach it to the inside of the front windshield.
3. Plug the included Type-C power adapter into the car cigarette lighter socket, connect the Type-C side of the power adapter to the device charging port, and then connect the camera to the device. Route the excess cable along the interior for a better look.
4. Start the car and the camera will automatically turn on. Before going on the road, make sure the camera lens is clean and without lens film, and nothing is blocking the lens.

Common Faults

DVR doesn't turn on: Check that the device is in the connected with right power.

DVR cannot record: Ensure whether the SD card is full or damaged. Format the SD card or replace the new SD card for trouble shooting.

Unclear picture quality: Check the DVR lens and the

windshield.

SD Card

The system supports up to 256GB Micro SD memory card. In order to maintain smooth video recording, it is recommended to use a high-speed card of Class 10 or above. At the same time, do not plug or unplug the SD card when the system is turned on to avoid damage to the SD card.

SD card is a consumable, please maintain it regularly, for example, format the SD card every 1-2 months.

Step1: APP download address: Download “Viidure” in APP store and install; Or can scan QR code to download it.
